UNIQUELY BLOOMING: A RARE ORCHID WAS DISCOVERED IN THE PARK

During the scientific expedition, the park's naturalists found a unique «Red Book» orchid - the Carpathian black orchid (Nigritella carpatica (Zapaf.) Teppner, Klein et Zagulski. This is a very rare relict endemic species, with only six known locations. The conservation status of the species is endangered!



THE DRAGONFLY FAUNA OF CHEREMOSKYI NNP HAS BEEN REPLENISHED WITH A NEW SPECIES

During a recent expedition to the territory of the Cheremoskyi NNP, a senior researcher of the Park, PhD, senior researcher D.I. Yuzyk discovered a new species for the list of our fauna in the Verishchykha ur.

It turned out to be a Pyrrhosoma nymphula (Pyrrhosoma nymphula Sulzer, 1776) from the family Coenagrionidae, which was previously recorded in the Chernivtsi region only in Dolishnyi Shepot. This is the second record in the Bukovinian Carpathians and the fourth in the Ukrainian Carpathians.

This odonata is rare in Europe and is listed in the European Red List (category LC).

A WILD DUCK NAMED «LAPKA» WAS TAKEN FOR REHABILITATION

Recently, Yaroslav Zelenchuk from the Verkhovynskyi NNP contacted us with a wild duck named «Lapka», whose left wing was injured, and handed it over to the rehabilitation center of the Cheremoshskyi NNP.

For a week, the Park's employees treated the bird and provided it with the necessary food, according to its food preferences, until it recovered its strength. After that, the wild duck was released into the wild - Klyauza on the Sarata River with other wild birds.

The pine marten was spotted by the State protection service of the nature reserve fund during a raid in the Park area.

The pine marten, also known as the European marten, is a small predator of the marten family. It is omnivorous, but prefers small mammals (e.g., voles, mice and vole), as well as birds and their eggs. In autumn, fruits, berries and nuts may be part of the diet.

This species of marten is an important component of forest ecosystems and an interesting animal to study and observe!

SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH EXPEDITION AND NEW SPECIES FOR THE PARK'S FAUNA LIST

During May, senior researcher D.I. Yuzyk made an expeditionary trip to the territory of the Cheremoskyi NNP, during which she conducted route-based biodiversity surveys on Tomnatyk Mountain, within the Bilyi Potik complex natural monument of local importance, micro-hydroelectric power plants on the Sarata River, on the Crown Prince Rudolf Cliff and in the Kalynychi Ur. During the expedition, she spotted roe deer (Capreolus) and found red deer (Cervus elaphus) droppings. Through singing and visual observations, I found 21 species of birds, namely: mallards, common buzzard, grouse, redshank, cuckoo, country swallows, wood lark, wood chickadee, white tit, magpie, raven, gray crow, shepherd's purse, black tit, alder, blackbird, blackbird, song thrush, marsh duck, great tit, black tit, and chaffinch. We monitored the population of artificial nesting sites with sparrow-like birds within the zoological PAs No. Z-3 and No. Z-4. We established the facts of nesting of titmouse and wrens. In addition, titmouse nests were occupied by hymenoptera.

At the phenopoint, I observed imago and fry of newts. As for invertebrates, I found red forest ants, common bee-eater, peacock eye butterflies and Aurora moth. In addition, I discovered 2 new species for the Park's fauna list - the spider Callobius claustraring Hahn, 1833 (a rare Palearctic species, the first find in Chernivtsi oblast) and the common slug Limax maximus L., 1758 (a common synanthropic species in Ukraine). With the help of SMART tools, we recorded flowering of anemone oak, scaly cross, perennial centipede, glandular toothwort, marsh puddleflower, meadow primrose, rejected violet, bicolor violet, Hungarian coinwort, common kittywort, medicinal dandelion), wild strawberries, Veronica dubro, red elderberry, milkweed, buttercup, cortex matthiola, as well as the Alpine fat woman listed in the Red Book of Ukraine and the end of flowering of Heifel's saffron, the vegetation of white hellebore, the appearance of buds in gray alder and rowan habitats. Conducted acoustic surveys of background bird species using an acoustic receiver in two transects (5-minute recordings of birdsong at 10 points in total) in the Perkalab and Selyatyn PAs.








NEW INFORMATION SIGNS WERE INSTALLED ON THE TERRITORY




On May 14, Maksym Vysoczyn, a field technician for environmental monitoring of the Ukrainian Carpathian Program of the Frankfurt Zoological Society in Ukraine // FZS Ukraine, ornithologist, PhD in biology, paid a working visit to the Cheremosky National Nature Park.

During the meeting, Maksym Vysoczyn held a training seminar for the NNPP employees responsible for working with SMART tools, focused on the peculiarities of setting up the data model for the effective use of the mobile version by the Park's employees to perform tasks in the areas of activity, and worked on setting up the synchronization of the computer version of the program. In addition, he shared his skills in decoding and analyzing passive acoustic bird monitoring data, helped to install and configure the Raven Pro software, and introduced the database of xenocontrolled birds.

MONTHLY FEATURE, FLOWER OF JUNE - STEMLESS GENTIAN

Stemless gentian (Gentiana acaulis L.).

Description: Perennial herb 5-10 cm tall. The leaves of the rosette are oval-elliptic, obtuse. Flowers are solitary. Calyx 20-30 mm long. Corolla 50-70 mm long, bluish-blue with olivegreen spots.

When it blooms: June - July. Fruits in August. Propagated by seeds and vegetatively.

Features: This species grows mainly in the alpine mountain belt, sometimes in the subalpine belt at an altitude of 1500-2000 m, on soddy areas and rocky scree.

Protection: It is forbidden to collect plants and disturb the habitat, in particular, excessive grazing.


