ABNORMAL CLIMATE CHANGE

On August 16, on the territory of the Cheremoskiy National Park, at the foot of Mount Tomnatyk, the park's employees found a real autumn mushroom (*Armillaria mellea*).

This type of mushroom usually begins to appear in late August and early September. Therefore, its sudden appearance is quite an anomaly.



CHERYOMSKIY NPP FAUNA REPLENISHMENT NEW SPECIES OF MOSQUITOES

During the processing of the entomological collections of the Park's employees for the previous years, the senior researcher of the Park, PhD, senior researcher Diana Yuzyk identified 2 new species of hymenoptera for the fauna list, namely the common hornet (*Vespa crabro* L., 1758) and the common xylocopa (*Xylocopa valga* Gerstaecker, 1872), the latter of which is rare and requires special protection measures.



THE BUTTERFLY FAUNA OF CHEREMOSKYI NNP HAS BEEN REPLENISHED WITH A NEW SPECIES

The unique nature of the Park becomes even more fascinating: a new species of butterflies appeared in its fauna, which was not previously known for this territory. Analyzing the entomological collections, the Park's scientist recently identified the lined moth (*Siona lineata*) among them. This new species not only pleases the eye with its color and unusual patterns on the wings, but also plays an important role in ecosystems. Its discovery emphasizes the importance of Cheremoskiy NNP as an important site for the conservation of biodiversity.

AUGUST BLOOMS

Very rare on the territory of Cheremoskiy NNP are the communities confined to the warm gentle slopes of the southern exposure near the carbonate rock outcrops of the Zhupany checkpoint. The floristic core is made up of cereals. Hygrophilous coenoses are common here, dominated by tall grasses that grow in areas with close groundwater.



AUGUST 19 - THE DAY OF THE BEEKEEPER OF UKRAINE

Congratulations to all Ukrainian beekeepers on their professional holiday! Your work is a sweet gift for each of us. NGO Center for Community Development Idea. Action. OFFSITE MEETING OF THE SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL COUNCIL AND THE COORDINATION COUNCIL AT CHERMOSKIY NNP

On September 17, an offsite meeting of the Scientific, Technical and Coordination Councils of the Chermoskiy National Nature Park was held on the territory of the Park. During which representatives of: Educational and Research Institute of Biology, Chemistry and Bioresources, Geography Faculty and Faculty of Architecture, Construction and Decorative and Applied Arts of Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University; Vyzhnytsia District Council; Selyatyn Territorial Community, the public and employees of the Chermoskiy National Park got acquainted with the recreational potential on the territory and with the report of the head of the institution on the results of the institution's activities for the period from January to August 2024.

The participants of the meeting made positive decisions on the issues on the agenda and approved the report of the director of the Chermoskiy NNP Roman Yerema for the above-mentioned period.

A REGULAR MEETING OF THE SCIENTIFIC AND TECHNICAL COUNCIL WAS HELD AT CHERMOSKIY NNP

On July 7, a regular meeting of the Scientific and Technical Council (STC) of the Cheremoskiy NNP was held in a mixed form, chaired by the park's director Roman Yerema.

Out of 27 members approved by the order of the Minister of Environmental Protection and Natural Resources of Ukraine, 20 members of the Scientific and Technical Council of the Cheremoskiy NNP took part in the meeting, 5 of whom joined the meeting via remote presence in the video conference mode using Zoom (the meeting was recorded).

These are representatives of: Vyzhnytsia District Council, Yuriy Fedkovych Chernivtsi National University, Chernivtsi Regional Council, NGO Institute of Communities, National Union of Local History of Ukraine, Verkhovynskiy National Nature Park, Putylske Forestry Branch of the State Specialized Enterprise Forests of Ukraine, Frankfurt Zoological Society in Ukraine, as well as employees of the Cheremoskiy National Nature Park.

Two issues were submitted for consideration by the Scientific and Technical Council. In particular, amendments to the composition of the Scientific and Technical Council of the Cheremoskiy NNP and approval of the Project for the organization of the territory of the Cheremoskiy National Nature Park, protection, reproduction and recreational use of its natural complexes and objects.

On the eve of the meeting, the members of the Scientific and Technical Council received the agenda, materials, and draft decisions for review. The members of the Scientific and Technical Council unanimously made positive decisions on the agenda, taking into account the comments, recommendations, and suggestions made.



INTERNATIONAL MEETING WITH A REPRESENTATIVE OF GLOBAL CONSERVATION

In early August, Mustafa Gönen, a representative of the international foundation Global Conservation, visited the Cheremoskiy National Nature Park. Together with the staff, we familiarized our guest with the territory and facilities, shared plans and ideas. During the meeting, they discussed further cooperation for the current and subsequent years. Next month, the park will receive the first package of necessary equipment. During the visit, they discussed the results of the Cheremoskyi National Nature Park work for 8 months of 2024. Prospects for the future work and expansion of the Park's territory.

The Cheremoskyi NNP continues to actively develop nature conservation and recreation, introducing new initiatives to preserve natural resources and create conditions for ecological recreation.

Therefore, new recreation areas have been created to improve the comfort of staying in the park, promote active recreation and popularize eco-tourism.

The recreational areas include equipped picnic areas, safe walking trails, and a camping area. An observation tower has also been built to watch wildlife and enjoy the beauty of the local flora and fauna in their natural environment.

MONTHLY COLUMN, SEPTEMBER FLOWER - AUTUMN LATE BLOOMER

The poisonous perennial plant is the autumn crocus (*Colchicum autumnale* L.). It is also known by the popular names wild saffron, wintergreen, frost, frosty.

Description: herbaceous perennial, cormy autumn geophemeroid with a long (more than 25 years) life cycle. Leaves are broadly lanceolate with a pointed apex, 12-30 cm x 1.5-7 cm in size. Flowers average 2-5, perianth pink or purple. Perianth segments are elliptical, 4-7 cm long. The fruit is a box.


When it blooms: in September-October, bears fruit in May-July of the following year. Propagated by seeds and vegetatively.

Features: all plant organs contain the poisonous alkaloid colchicine. In addition, the flowers of the late flower contain apigenin, the seeds contain tannins, fat, resin, sugar, and the leaves contain a complex of 20 alkaloids, colchicoside, asparagine, and inulin.

Conservation: It is necessary to control the state of populations. Unauthorized collection of plants and disturbance of habitats is prohibited.




