

NEW INFORMATION SIGNS FOR CONVENIENCE AND EXPLORATION OF THE CHEREMOSKIY NATIONAL NATURE PARK

New information stands for visitors have appeared on the territory of the Chermoskiy National Nature Park.

Large information stands are located at the bus station and at key road intersections. Small stands provide information about interesting natural objects directly on tourist routes and in recreational areas. The structures are designed to withstand mountain conditions, so they are durable and easy to use. More than half of the planned signs have already been installed, and work is continuing. These signs are primarily intended for tourists: they help them easily navigate the territory, learn more about unique natural sites and routes, and feel more confident when traveling in the mountains. These are not just signposts, but a kind of guide that makes visiting the Park more enjoyable and memorable.

We sincerely thank FZT for their help in manufacturing and installing the information stands. Thanks to our joint efforts, staying in the Park is not only more comfortable, but also more informative and safer!

EDUCATIONAL ACTIVITIES FOR YOUNG RESEARCHERS

Specialists from the Chermoskiy National Nature Park conducted an interesting and informative lesson on Natural Disasters with preschoolers from the Putylsky Preschool Educational Institution. The children learned what earthquakes, storms, and floods are and how to behave during such events. Together, we looked at illustrations and discussed the causes of natural disasters and ways to overcome them. A special moment of the lesson was the experiment How to simulate rain in a glass. Each child independently created a small cloud in a transparent glass. This evoked a sea of emotions, surprise, and sincere children's interest in nature!



LEARNING ABOUT NATURE - LEARNING TO PROTECT IT

Recently, members of the Ecological Local History club (students of the Galician Secondary School I-II) took part in an outdoor educational event called Environmental Protection is Everyone's Business. The purpose of the meeting was not only to enjoy the beauty of nature, but also to realize the importance of its preservation. During the event, students familiarized themselves with the zoning map of the Chermoskiy National Nature Park, learned about protected, recreational, and economic zones, and discussed permitted activities and their role in preserving natural complexes. The children visually identified the boundaries of the territories and combined theoretical knowledge with practical observations. In the second part of the event, students created mini-projects on environmental protection, proposing ideas for eco-trails, waste sorting, tree planting, and eco-campaigns. They also discussed current environmental issues in the region and concluded that nature conservation begins with each individual.





ECO-EDUCATIONAL MEETING – EXCHANGE OF EXPERIENCE AND NEW STRATEGIES

A warm and meaningful meeting dedicated to discussing eco-education strategies for Ukraine's national parks took place in Yaremche, in the Carpathian National Nature Park. The event brought together experts in environmental education and the promotion of nature conservation values. It was organized by the Frankfurt Zoological Society, which has been supporting Ukrainian nature conservation institutions for many years. During the meeting, the parks' environmental education programs were presented, including an inspiring presentation by Hanna Kuzyo and Lucy Flaschgauer. IMMERSION INTO HISTORY: A KRYIVKA AS A SYMBOL OF RESISTANCE

On the occasion of the Bukovynian Viche Day, members of the Environmental Local Studies club visited a reconstructed kryivka on the Horby hamlet of the Ust-Putyla community — a unique historical site of Bukovyna. Here, school students immersed themselves in the events of the Ukrainian people's liberation struggle. The kryivka was created by Mykola Shtefuriak, a descendant of UPA fighters and the father of a defender of Ukraine. According to him, about 20 kryivkas once operated in the Putyla district. Today, it serves as a museum and a center of national and patriotic education, which is especially important in times of war. Glory to Ukraine! Glory to the Heroes!

SUMMER MONITORING ANALYSIS

Employees of the Chermoskiy National Nature Park's Nature Reserve Department analyzed summer monitoring data obtained using camera traps installed in the park. The results of the observations confirm the activity and diversity of the animal species, indicating the stable state of natural ecosystems and the effectiveness of conservation measures.



PROTECTING NATURE — EVERYDAY WORK

In order to prevent violations of environmental legislation, employees of the State Protection Service of Chermoskiy NNP carried out a regular patrol event. During the patrol, natural areas were inspected and compliance with the protection regime of the territory was checked.

From November 3 to 14, 2025, the NNP held technical training for nature conservation specialists on updated regulatory requirements, protocol preparation, and working with the SMART program to improve employee professional training.




GEOLOGICAL SURVEY OF THE SARATA RIVERBED IN CHERMOSKIY NNP

Researchers of Chermoskiy NNP conducted a field trip within the Park to examine geological formations along the Sarata Riverbed. During field observations, a visual assessment of the rock composition exposed in the floodplain and river channel was carried out. The survey revealed a significant presence of limestone and quartz rocks, which form the basis of the local geological landscape. In certain areas, characteristic layers and strata are visible, formed as a result of long-term tectonic and hydrogeological processes. Such observations are an important component of monitoring natural elements and help refine the understanding of the geological structure of Chermoskiy NNP.



AUTUMN IN CHERMOSKIY NNP — A TIME FOR OBSERVATION AND INSPIRATION

Recently, a scientific research expedition was carried out by a senior researcher of Chermoskiy NNP to monitor the condition of ecosystems. Autumn activity of birds and mammals was recorded, along with new growth sites for fungi and lichens, and the transition of nature into the winter period. Such observations help track natural cycles and changes related to climate and human impact.



RED DEER (CERVUS ELAPHUS)

A red deer was recently recorded in Cheremoskyi NNP. The red deer is the most widespread deer species in the world. In Ukraine, these animals inhabit the Carpathians and Crimea, while globally, they live in forests, steppes, and deserts, usually near rivers and streams. Their diet includes at least 300 plant species, mainly grasses, leaves, shoots, and mushrooms. In the wild, their lifespan is approximately 15–20 years.



Interesting facts:

- Red deer shed their antlers every year and grow new ones;
- The red deer is the largest deer species; an adult can weigh over 300 kg;
- The red deer can jump distances of 5–6 meters;
- Their noble appearance and beauty have made red deer popular in heraldry, appearing on the coats of arms of many cities.






